**INSPIRITEC, INC. RECEIVES
2007 INGLIS AWARD FOR CONTINUING EXCELLENCE**

Philadelphia, PA (June 2007) – InspiriTec, Inc. is proud to announce it received a 2007 Inglis Award for Continuing Excellence. Its inbound call center business has served consumers in the areas of medical assistance recipient services, public utilities customer assistance, welfare-to-work participant services and private healthcare insurance.
